## Tattoo Aftercare

- After your tattoo is completed, the artist will apply a light layer of aftercare product and wrap it in a protective barrier. Leave this barrier on overnight.
- In the morning (preferably in the shower) remove the protective barrier and wash the tattoo thoroughly with unscented soap (foaming soap is recommend)
- It is important not to over soak the tattoo.
- Make sure to not over work the area and allow to air dry.
- Once the tattoo is dry, apply a thin layer of aftercare to the tattoo, do not use too much so that the tattoo cant breathe. Repeat this process for at least 3-4 times a day for the first 5 days,
- On the 5th day, repeat the washing process and instead of applying aftercare product, apply skin care lotion (lubriderm).
- Repeat this process for the next 5 days.
- Avoid any pools, rivers or oceans for the first 3 weeks.

### Texas state care for tattoos.

For at least two weeks, minimize exposure to the sun, discourage swimming; properly cleanse the tattoo area. Apply antibiotic ointment or cream, use sterile badge or other sterile dressing when necessary.

The client shall consult a health care practitioner at the first sign of infection or allergic reaction and report any diagnosed infection, allergic reaction or adverse reaction resulting from the tattoo to the tattoo artist and to the Texas Department of health services, drugs and medical devices group at 18888396676
